Whether you're a new user or you've been working with SAP SuccessFactors for years, there's one thing everyone has to go through: **bi-annual release updates.**

Let's face it, managing releases takes a lot of effort. You have to learn new features, rethink processes, and update reference materials – all in just a few weeks.





Time and time again, we've had our customers ask us how to prepare for a new release – sometimes in the last minute. However, the predictability of the release cycle can work to your advantage if you:

- Go in with a strategy
- Have your go-to tools accessible
- Build scheduled habits

We've been working on these for quite some time now, so we've got some tricks up our sleeves.

With that in mind, we created this handy toolkit to share with the SAP Community – so that you have the best tools out there ready in your back pocket for managing the releases to come. Some might be familiar (that's great) and some might be new. Either way, the resources here will make your release management process a whole lot smoother.

To make sure your life is as easy as possible, we've equipped every tool-related page with the same structure.

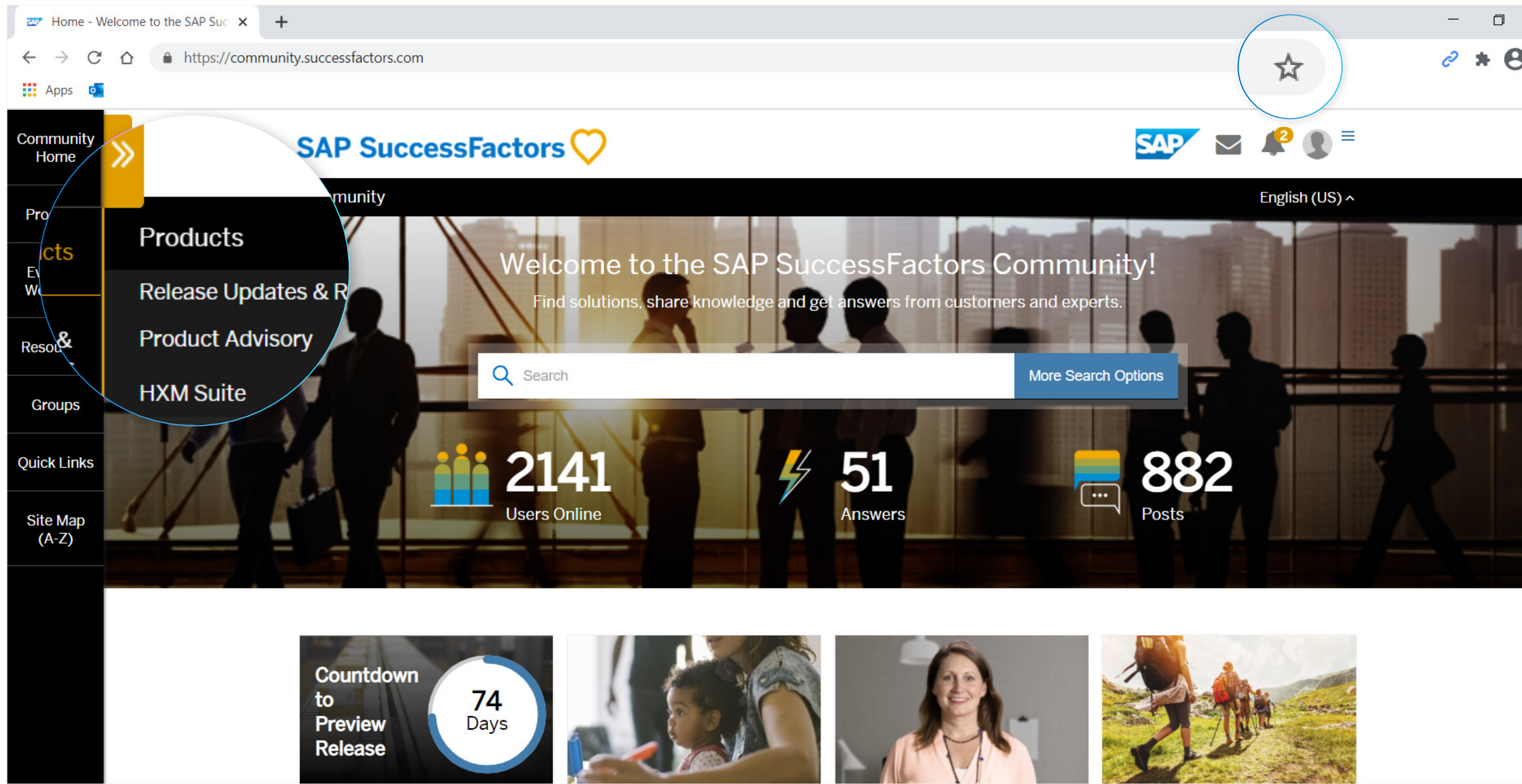
You can familiarize with what the tool looks like with the visual screenshot, get the gist of its benefits with the written description and if you're in a rush, note the key takeaways with the "too long, didn't read" section (or as we like to call it - the TLDR).



SAP Customer Community Site

The **SAP Customer Community Site** should be your home base for release updates. Within this site you'll find everything including quick links to resources and the Product Updates Blog, which provides targeted content for each release cycle.





The best part about the SAP Customer Community site is (intuitively) the community. There's a lot of action from the user community in the comments throughout the site, especially around release season. We like to check in every few days to see what people are talking about and how SAP is responding.



Bookmarking this page is a must for easy access. It's an even better idea to subscribe to it so that you receive notifications whenever there is notable new content.

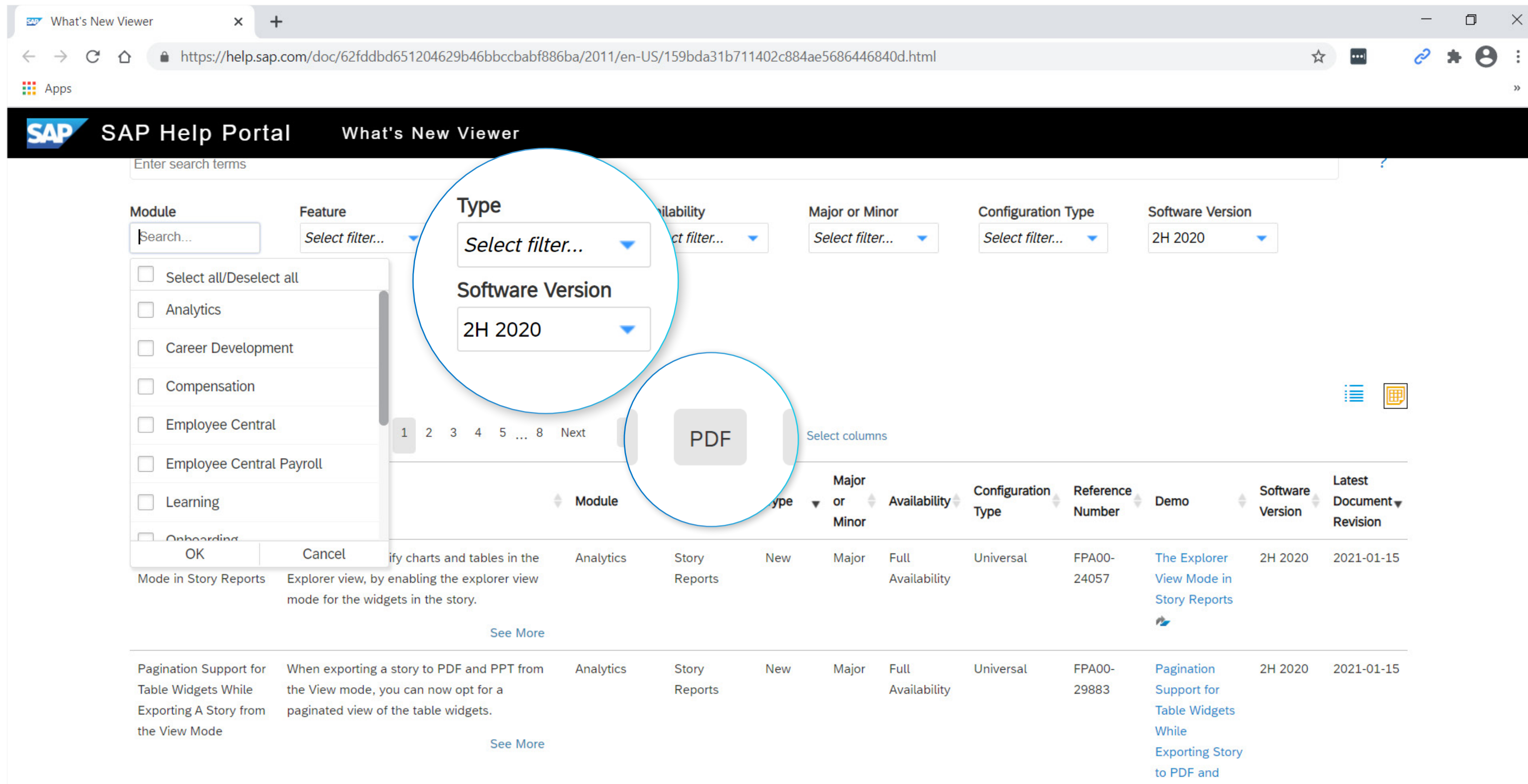

SAP What's New Release Viewer

The **What's New Release Viewer** is a game changer when it comes to managing your releases. It provides a complete overview of all of the SAP SuccessFactors features and functional updates. It allows you to see everything in one place without you having to go through content that isn't useful for you.





The filters at the top of the Viewer allow you to draw entries that are most relevant to you - covering everything from modules, availability, configuration type, and when the latest revision occurred.

You have the option of downloading the table of results into a PDF document but if you find something that particularly interests you, you can see additional notes, reminders, before and after screenshots and demo videos when you click “See More”.

Overall, the What’s New Release Viewer offers a more user-friendly experience to learning about the changes than a traditional workbook.

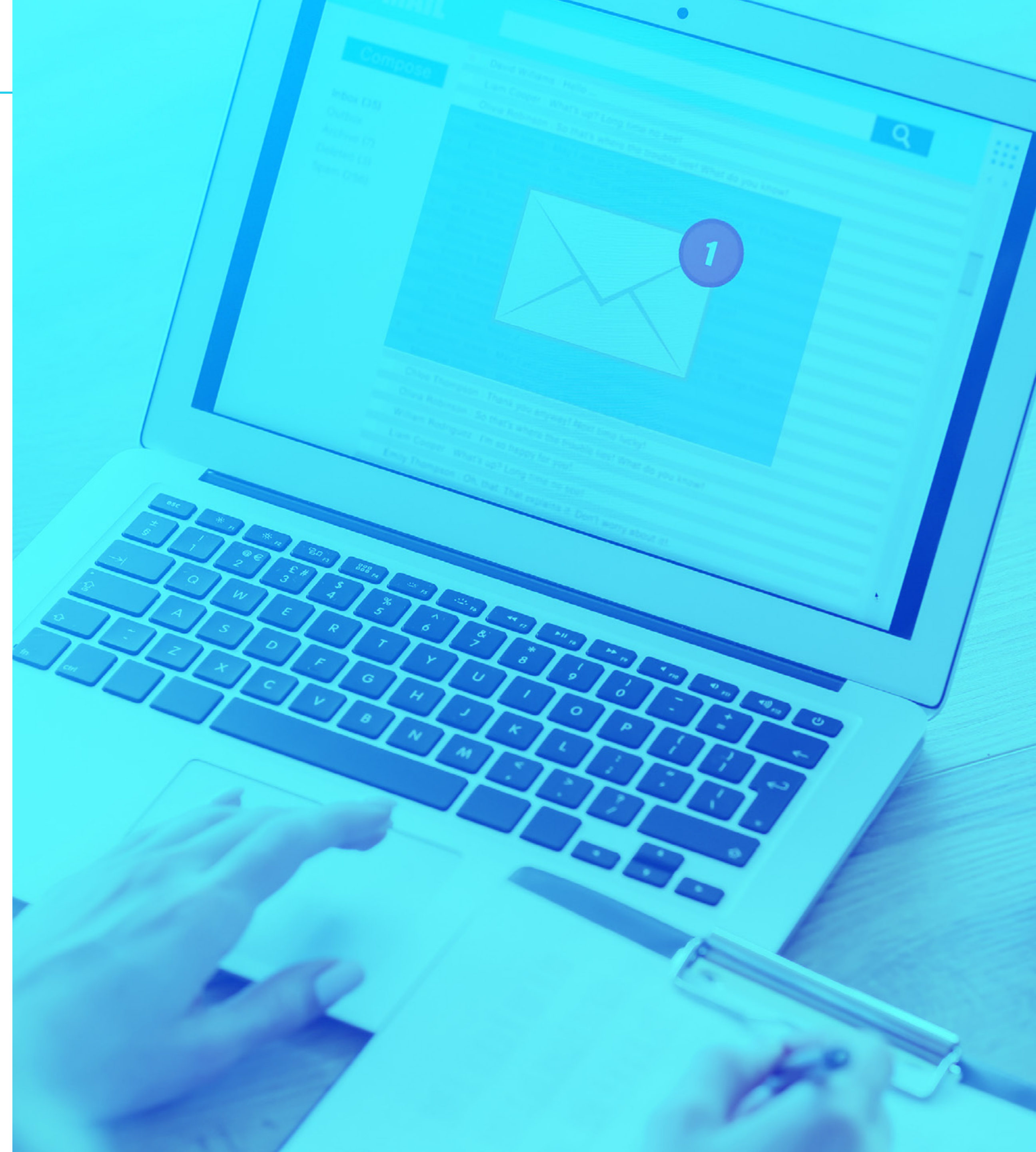

Innovation Alerts Dashboard

The **Innovation Alerts Dashboard** is a tool within the SAP Customer Community that provides a list of updates that require you to take action or prepare more change management than others. Some of these items will specify feature migrations and whether a feature will no longer be maintained or is being faded out.



Product Updates Blog

Innovation Alert communications are a supplement to typical release communications like the [What's New Viewer](#) and are initiated by SAP SuccessFactors when proactive change management and/or communications are deemed especially necessary for an effective transition experience. As such, not every feature or functionality being introduced or deprecated within a release will necessitate an Innovation Alert.

Functionally, an Innovation Alert proactively communicates, when applicable, self-service instructions, deprecation dates, change management resources, and communication channels for a:

- Feature or functionality deprecation
- Migration to a next-generation feature, functionality, or solution

The dashboard consolidates the update list based on module so you can stay up to date on what's relevant to you. To make sure you find exactly what you're looking for, you can filter and search within the tool.

Because the Innovation Alerts Dashboard changes frequently and requires you to be proactive on updating your own SAP SuccessFactors system, it's important to subscribe to alerts.

SAP SuccessFactors Test Cases

SAP SuccessFactors Test Cases show end-users how changes to the system might impact their specific SuccessFactors instance – from both a process and visual perspective. This feature is usually available shortly after the release hits preview and is especially useful for universal changes.



Checking the Contingent Worker Field Configuration (ECT-122445) ☆

Use the following steps to test the new feature about using the check tool to verify the contingent worker field configuration.

Business Scenario

In this case, we check whether the `isContingentWorker` field is configured correctly in the Employment Information HRIS element.

Steps

| Step | Result/Additional Info |
|--|---|
| 1. In Admin Center, go to Manage Business Configuration > employmentInfo and search for <code>isContingentWorker</code> field. | - |
| 2. Select Details and set the Enabled field to Yes and save the setting. | The <code>isContingentWorker</code> field is enabled for the Employment Information HRIS element. |

It is crucial that you run the test scenarios in your preview instance in case one of the changes negatively affects your existing processes. If the tests run smoothly, then you can look into moving the changes into your production instance.

Test Cases give you a great opportunity to see if any guides or reference videos need to be modified, or if you need to prepare any change management.



To save time testing the scenarios, prioritize the changes by impact:

1. universal (**high immediate impact**),
2. opt-out (**medium immediate impact**),
3. opt-in (**low immediate impact**).

SAP SuccessFactors Patch Details

SAP provides an overview of customer-reported issues that are fixed in two-week “patches” throughout and after the releases known as the Patch Details.



Latest Patch Details

Tip: Click 'Spoiler' to expand the listing of the customer-reported issues within a patch! The details of a patch, which includes customer-reported issues, are typically published the day a patch is applied to Preview instances. Please subscribe at the top of this blog to be notified as soon as a patch's details are published.

Each Patch has its own separate link allowing you to search by modules or reference numbers. Each Patch also has its own Knowledge Base Article (KBA) containing the list that you can download into a PDF file.

The Patches not only notify you of known issue resolutions but provide workarounds to existing issues and time frames as to when existing issues might be resolved.



For a quick fix, you can visit the Customer Community Calendar and look for the upcoming patches there.

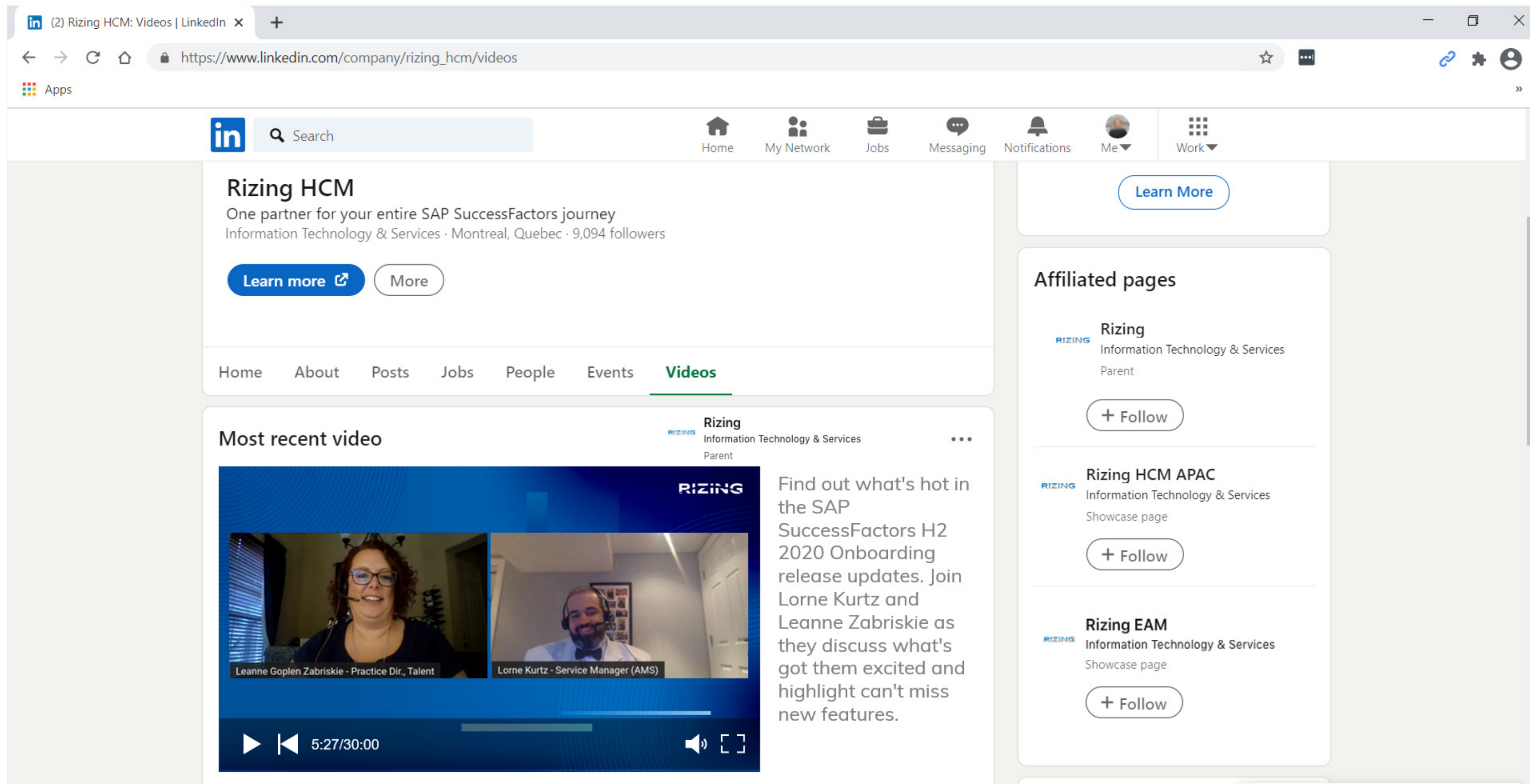

Release Management Strategy Checklist

Like we said at the beginning, managing releases isn't easy. We have given you all the tools you need to succeed. But to keep you organized, here's a quick checklist you can rely on when you're planning your release strategy or rolling out your next steps:

I marked my calendar for the Preview release date... but I also marked my calendar to start planning a few weeks prior

I prepared my team by identifying who is responsible for which action items to make sure I have the right resources lined up to get our system ready

I have a week-by-week breakdown of my strategy and approach so that there are no discrepancies when it's game-time

I have subscribed to the tools that will help me

I have registered for SAP's Q&A session and submitted my questions in advance

I poked around the What's New Viewer and began analyzing the system changes in my Preview instance

After the production release, I first did a validation in my preview instance and then validated in production to make sure my day-to-day processes continue to run smoothly



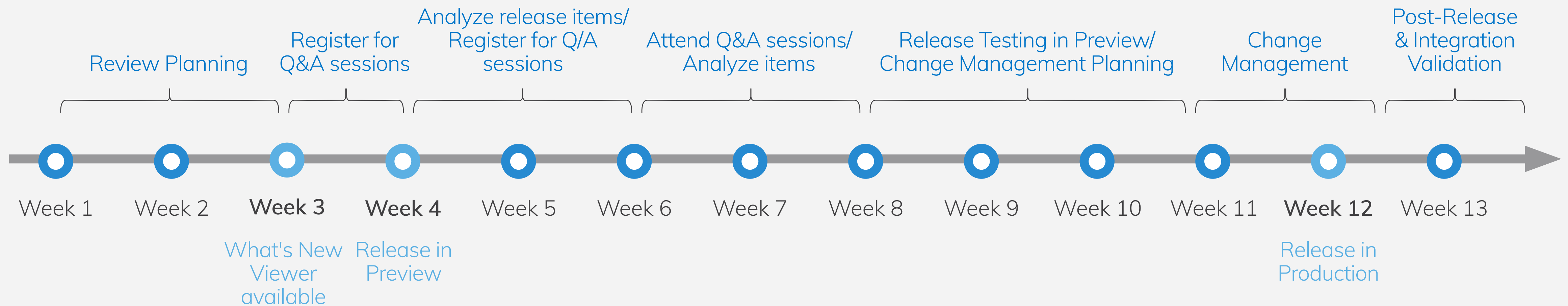
With that, you have everything you need to be a pro at managing releases. **Good luck – even though you don't need it.**
